Foodshare Meets Goal for Turkey Donations

Financial Contributions Still Needed

Expecting to turn away families who had signed up to receive a turkey for Thanksgiving, Foodshare officials made an emergency appeal for donations Monday. “We started the day needing 3,000 turkeys, and I did not think we could make it,” said Gloria McAdam, President of Foodshare. “However, as the word got out about the need, hundreds of local individuals, organizations, and businesses stepped forward, and incredibly, all 3,000 turkeys were donated on Monday.”

Foodshare will distribute 3,200 holiday turkeys on Tuesday.

Foodshare also has a goal of raising \$260,000 in the month of November. These funds will help Foodshare provide food to hungry people throughout the year. An additional \$28,615 is needed by Friday for Foodshare to meet this goal.
